- Brought a feminine touch to the winery, emphasizing that inner balance and outer appearance are equally important.



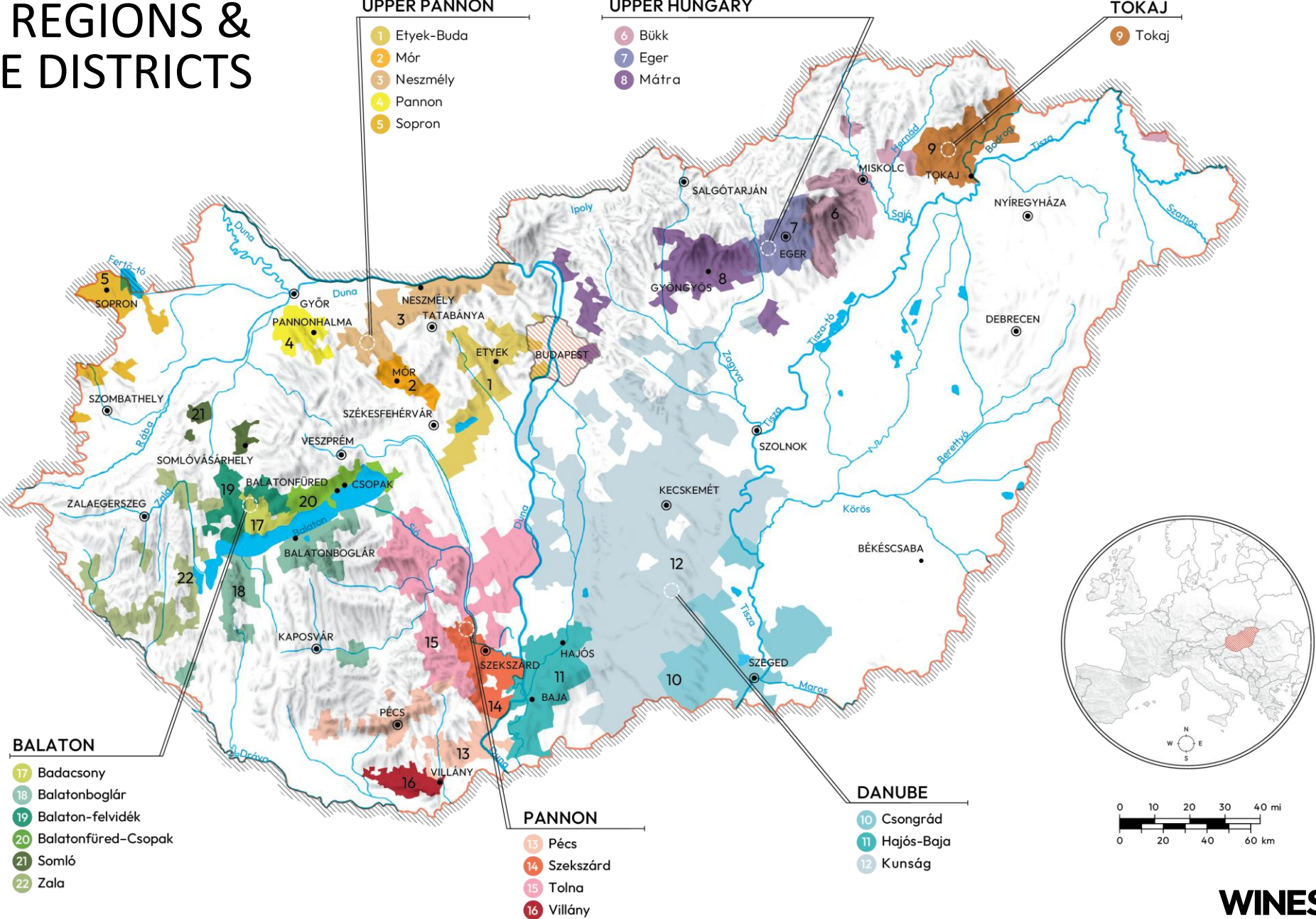
GYÖRGY LŐRINCZ JR

Szentpéteri Borpince

- Year of foundation: 1997
- Area under vine: 65 ha
- Wine region & district: Danube - Kunság
- Main grape varieties: Néró, Kékfrankos, Kadarka, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Olaszrizling, Irsai Olivér
- Wine type: white, rosé, red

SZENTPÉTERI BORPINCE

The aim is to produce varietal, premium wines that offer good value for money, while also creating exciting and distinctive wines for customers. In addition, there is a desire to contribute to the reputation of the Kunsági wine region and to provide an unforgettable experience for visitors.



SZENTPÉTERI BORPINCSE KADARKA ROSÉ BRUT

- **Grapes:** Kadarka
- **Soil:** clay, loess sand, sometimes calcareous
- **Acidity:** 8 g/l
- **Dosage:** 6 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 12 %
- **Winemaking and ageing:** Traditional bottle fermentation. Aged for 1,5 years in bottle. An optimal vintage for sparkling wine production, relatively cool spring and the beginning of the summer was more even, with cooler nights and warmer days.

Did you know...

The winery is 3 generations old, their grandfather started with a few capital Kadarka. When his son took over he made the Néró grape variety famous in Hungary, which eventually became their flagship variety.

- Main grape varieties: Kadarka, Kékfrankos, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon
- Wine type: white, rosé, red

ESZTERBAUER WINERY

The Eszterbauer family, spanning 10 generations, upholds a rich tradition of winemaking in Szekszárd, Hungary since 1746. Their wines, dominated by reds like Kadarka and Kékfrankos, reflect the region's diversity and heritage. With a modern processing facility and warm hospitality at their wine and guesthouse, they offer a true taste of Szekszárd, contributing not only to its wine culture but also to community support and cultural enrichment.



ESZTERBAUER

„NAGYAPÁM” KADARKA 2024

- **Grape:** Kadarka
- **Soil:** Bodzás: thick homogeneous loess; Porkoláb-valley: loess with patches of clay and loam; Palánki-hill: loess mixed with deposits
- **Acidity:** 5,1 g/l
- **Residual sugar:** 1,1 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 13,18 %
- **Winemaking and ageing:** Spontaneous fermentation, only aged in stainless steel tanks. 2024 was the hottest year since 1901, with average temperatures up to 2,1° C above the 1991-2020. Due to the change in weather budburst and flowering occurred up to 10-14 days earlier than usual.

Did you know...

The winery's oldest vineyard is 114 years old, which means it was planted the same year the Titanic sank.

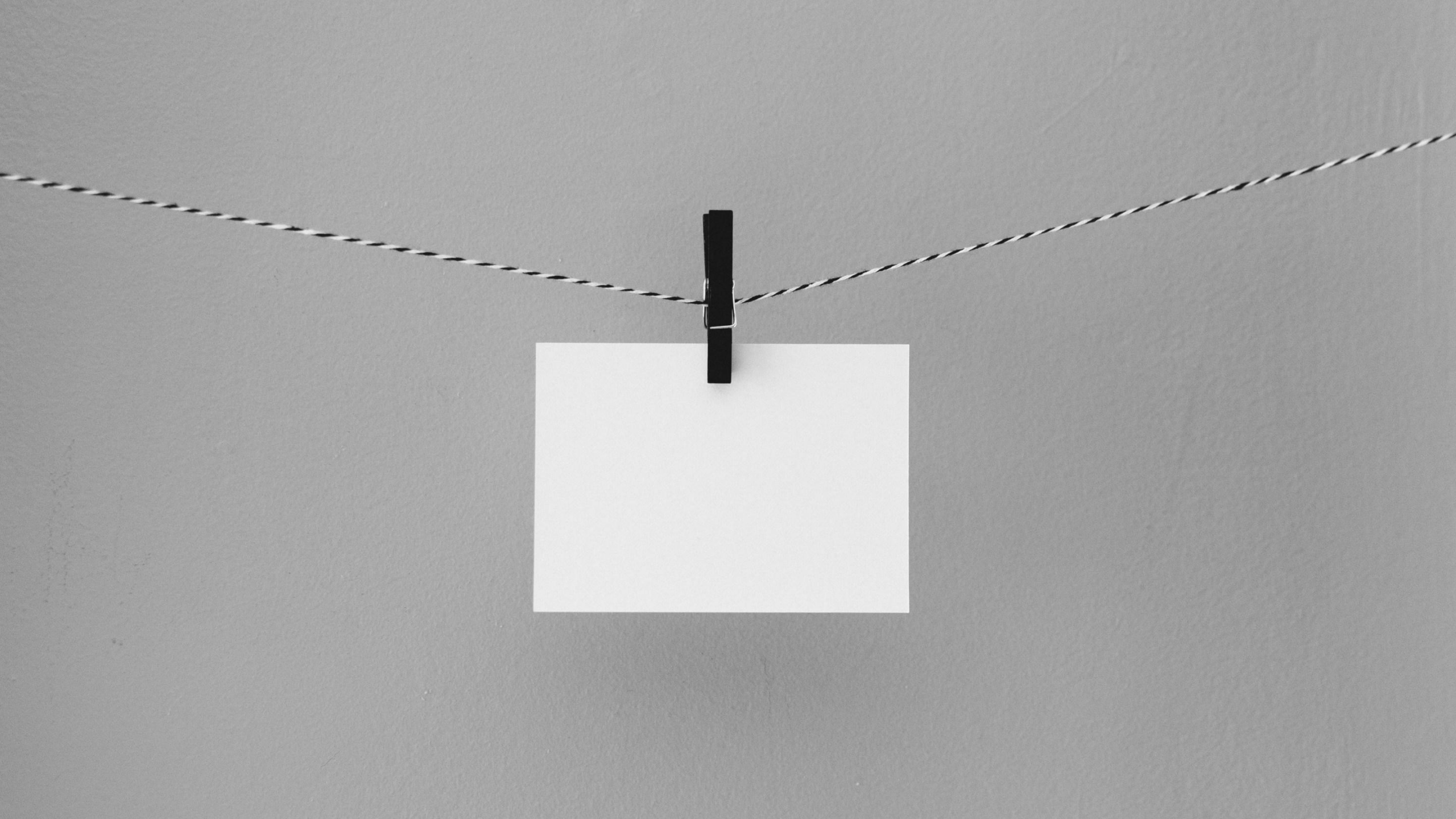

- Year of foundation: 2020
- Area under vine: 7,6 ha
- Wine region & district: Balaton - Badacsony
- Main grape varieties: Cabernet Franc, Kékfrankos, Olaszrizling, Pinot Noir, Rajnai Rizling, Muscat Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris, Grüner Veltliner
- Wine type: white, red

ILLÉS WINERY

The first vintage of this boutique winery, 2020, came about thanks to an unexpected event: three days before the harvest, the buyer of that year's crop stepped back. After the initial panic, instead of focusing on the problem, attention was turned to the opportunity, and winemaking began. For years, there was only planning and dreaming, until the situation led to the production of the first vintage wines. Nearly five years have passed, and based on experience and learning from mistakes, pure, honest wines are crafted that can still be identified with. The volcanic wines, made with respect for traditions but with a modern approach, convey the elegant message of the terroir.



ILLÉS WINERY

KÉKFRANKOS 2022

- **Grape:** Kékfrankos
- **Soil:** volcanic basalt monadnock mix with clay and loess, rich in minerals like iron, magnesium, calcium
- **Acidity:** 5,1 g/l
- **Residual sugar:** <1 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 12,5 %
- **Winemaking and ageing:** Fermented in open tanks with regular manual punch-downs to ensure gentle extraction and preserve the variety's vibrant fruit and spice character. Aged for 12 months in 300 L Kalina barrels made of Hungarian Zemplén oak.

Did you know...

The winery is deepening its commitment to organic production. Vineyard work is carried out with minimal intervention & strong ecological focus, guided by the expertise of Olivér Weingartner.



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Luka Pincészet

- Year of foundation: 2010
- Area under vine: 3 ha
- Wine region & district: Upper Pannon - Sopron
- Main grape varieties: Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir, Kékfrankos, Zweiglet
- Wine type: red

LUKA PINCÉSZET

The tradition of winegrowing in this region goes back for centuries. The vineyards are located in the hills between Fertőrákos and Balf, where the unique climate of Lake Fertő, the excellent soil, and abundant sunshine provide ideal conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Blue Frankish, and Zweigelt wines.



LUKA PINCÉSZET SOPRONI TURÁN 2022

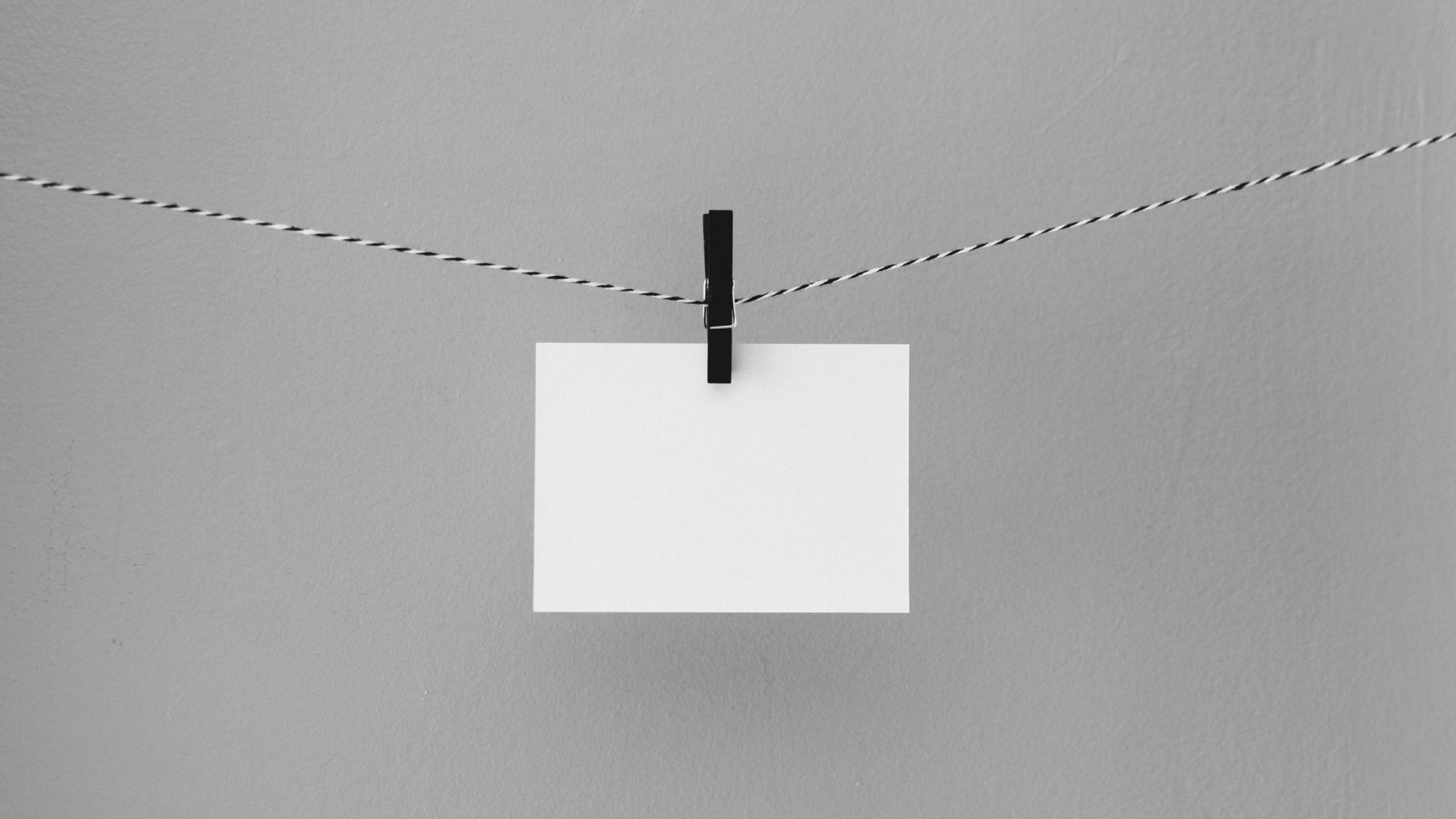
- **Grapes:** Turán
- **Acidity:** 5,2 g/l
- **Residual sugar:** 0,4 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 14 %
- **Winemaking and ageing:** Fermented in opened vessel.

Did you know...

The winery has been run by Enikő Luka since her father's death. They harvest exclusively their own grapes from 3,5 hectares.

- Area under vine: 48 ha
- Wine region & district: Upper Hungary - Eger
- Main grape varieties: Kékfrankos, Kadarka, Furmint, Hárslevelű, Olaszrizling
- Wine type: white, red

ST. ANDREA WINERY

The most important task for St. Andrea is to produce unique and high quality wines that can only be produced in their home region of Eger. They make their wines with traditional and natural methods, guided by affection and vocation. They pay special attention to the traditional varieties of their wine region, such as Olaszrizling, Hárslevelű, Furmint, Kadarka and Kékfrankos. They try to get to know their region, to improve their grape production year by year, to refine and adapt the wine-making process to the different grape varieties. They also try to understand the essence of their earthly mission.



ST. ANDREA WINERY HANGÁCS CRU EGRI BIKAVÉR GRAND SUPERIOR 2022

- **Grapes:** Kékfrankos, Merlot, Kadarka, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc
- **Acidity:** 5,6 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 14,5 %
- **Winemaking and ageing:** 16 months, in 5 hl Hungarian oak

Did you know...

According to the legend from Eger, the name “Bikavér” (Bull’s Blood) comes from the time of the Turkish invasions: during the 1552 siege of Eger Castle, to strengthen the castle defenders against the overwhelming Ottoman forces, Captain István Dobó had red wine brought up from the cellars.

Gere Attila Winery

- Area under vine: 75 ha
- Wine region & district: Pannon - Villány
- Main grape varieties: Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Fekete Járdovány, Medoc Noir, Olaszrizling
- Wine type: carbonated sparkling, white, rosé, red

GERE ATTILA WINERY

The history of the Gere Attila Winery started seven generations ago. Their ancestors have passed on their skills from one generation to the next. The perfectly ripe, hand selected, organically cultivated grapes are taken to a cellar equipped with state-of-the-art technology. Fermentation takes place either in steel tanks or wooden vats. After gentle extraction, the wines are raked into top-quality Hungarian small oak barrels, and after bottling, their ageing continues. This is what makes Kopar, Solus and Attila unique, complex and elegant, thus they can stand up to the world's great wines!



GERE ATTILA WINERY

A. GERE VILLÁNYI FRANC ÖRDÖGÁROK 2021

- **Grape:** Cabernet Franc
- **Acidity:** 4,8 g/l
- **Residual sugar:** <0,4 g/l
- **Alcohol content:** 14 %

Did you know...

Cabernet Franc is more than just a blending grape. In cooler climates, it often produces vibrant, peppery wines all on its own, long before Cabernet Sauvignon ripens.
